Draft CEA-2013, Digital STB Power Consumption, is hereby submitted to R4 for comment period (pre-vote). Your response to comment period (pre-vote) is due to [jjohnson@ce.org](mailto:jjohnson@ce.org) <BLOCKED::BLOCKED::<mailto:jjohnson@ce.org>> (with a copy to R4 WG13 Co-Chairs Gary Langille, Echostar [Gary.Langille@echostar.com](mailto:Gary.Langille@echostar.com) , & Chris Stone, Motorola [chris.j.stone@motorola.com](mailto:chris.j.stone@motorola.com) ) by February 10.

A single draft is attached (WITHLinks) [since this draft is proposed as a New standard, there are no revs—yet]. Your response by February 10 will permit the remaining steps necessary to permit R4 to vote to adopt this standard during its March 9 meeting in Clearwater, FL. In addition, notice of an R4 WG13 telcon, where CPP responses will be addressed, will be forwarded shortly. R4 members responding to CPP are encouraged to attend.

Please enter each of your company's comments with suggested alternative language in the attached Excel document (it will help me to consolidate). For each comment, R4 members' response should include the information elements in the following example:

1. E/S: Pls use the entry "E" or "S" to indicate whether the proposed revision is editorial or substantive.
2. Section #: Please enter the section number of draft CEA-2013 to which your proposed revisions apply.
3. Paragraph #, Table #, Figure# (of attached draft CEA-2013...CPP.pdf) ,
4. The existing text that is the subject of the comment (the text you suggest revising);

5. Suggested Alternative Language (Required for each comment), for example "Change 'packet information' to 'XDS packet information' throughout." [FYI, RTR means Revise to Read]

6. Reason: A Brief reason for the proposed revision. For example, editorial clarification.

This comment period (pre-vote) is also R4 members' "golden" opportunity to suggest revisions to the draft, ask questions, or suggest alternative language. Pls contact R4 WG13 Co-Chairs Stone, Motorola, & Langille, Echostar, and/or CEA staff if you have questions, prior to submitting your response.

Also, just to keep it up front, the Patent Disclosure Request (also contained on the first page of each draft) is repeated:

#### Patent Disclosure Request:

If your company has a patent(s) or pending patents(s) that is/are required to implement this draft standard, CEA requires a statement from the patent applicant or holder indicating compliance with the CEA intellectual property rights policy by stating one of the following:

1. a license shall be made available without charge to applicants desiring to use the patent for the purpose of implementing the standard, or

2. a license shall be made available to applicants under reasonable terms and conditions that are demonstrably free of any unfair discrimination.

If your company knows of existing patent(s) held by another company that is/are required to implement this draft standard, notify CEA staff. CEA staff will contact the company to request the above statement from the patent applicant or holder indicating compliance with the CEA intellectual property rights policy as indicated above.
